WEATHER ADVISORY BY PMD/FFD

More Monsoon Rains Thundershowers Predicted in Northern Half of the Country From Friday to Thursday (12th to 18th July, 2019)

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD), Islamabad, has issued a Weather Advisory on the developing meteorological situation in the context of monsoon currents and westerly wave. The Advisory says:

"Moderate Monsoon Currents from Arabian Sea are continuously penetrating in Northeastern parts and likely to strengthen in upper parts of Pakistan from Friday evening/night (July 12, 2019). Westerly Wave is also expected to enter upper parts of Pakistan on Sunday (July 14, 2019)". Salient features are:

- Widespread rain/thundershower (few Moderate to Heavy Falls) with windstorm is expected in Kashmir & Islamabad besides, Rawalpindi, Sargodha, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad Divisions of Punjab including Malakand, Hazara, Peshawar, Mardan, Kohat, Bannu Divisions of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from Friday evening/night to Thursday (12th to 18th July, 2019).
- Rain dust thundershower is expected at isolated places in Zhob, D.I.Khan, D.G.Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur and Sahiwal Divisions from Sunday evening/night to Thursday (14th to 18th July, 2019).
- **Heavy to Very Heavy** falls are also expected at isolated places in Hazara, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore Divisions, Islamabad and Kashmir during the period.

The predicted **Heavy Falls** may generate flash flooding in local nullahs/riverine areas of Hazara Division (KP), Gujranwala, D.G. Khan Divisions of Punjab besides Kashmir and may trigger landslides in Hazara Division (KP) and Kashmir. **Possibility of urban flooding in Lahore, Gujranwala, Faisalabad, Rawalpindi Divisions cannot be ruled out during the aforementioned period.**

With above likely meteorological situation in view, all concerned authorities are advised to remain **ALERT**, critically watch the weather situation and must take all necessary precautionary measures to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private & public property.
