




MORE RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY DURING THE CURRENT WEEK

Pakistan Meteorological Department, Islamabad has issued Press Release on the developing Meteorological prevailing conditions. According to PMD, Westerly Wave is presently affecting upper and central parts of the country. This weather system is likely to interact with monsoon currents on **Wednesday (evening/night) (2nd October 2019)** and it will grip most parts of the country on **Thursday (3rd October 2019)**. Under the influence of this weather system following weather is expected;

- **Widespread** wind-thunderstorm/rain (**with few moderate to isolated heavy falls**) is expected in all Districts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, upper Punjab (Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sargodha, Lahore and Faisalabad), Islamabad, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from **Wednesday to Sunday (2nd October to 6th October 2019)**. While rain/thunderstorm may also occur in all Districts of D.G.Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur and Sahiwal from **Wednesday (Evening) to Saturday (2nd October to 5th October 2019)**.
- Scattered wind-thunderstorm/rain is expected in Districts of Balochistan from **Wednesday (Evening) to Friday (2nd October to 4th October 2019)**.
- Wind-thunderstorm/rain is expected at scattered places in all Districts of Sukkur, Larkana, Shaheed Benazirbad, Mirpurkhas, Hyderabad and Karachi from **Wednesday (Evening) to Saturday (2nd October to 5th October 2019)**.
- Hail-Windstorm is also expected at isolated places in Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Punjab, Northern Balochistan and upper Sindh during the period.

Heavy rains may trigger landslides in Districts of Malakand, Hazara, Gilgit Baltistan and Kashmir during **next 4-5 days**.

All concerned organizations (PDMA, DDMA, WASAs, District Administrations and Provincial Irrigation Departments) are accordingly advised to remain **Fully Alert**, watch the weather situation closely and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time, so as to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private & public property.
