




**RAINS PREDICTED IN UPPER AND CENTRAL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY
FROM SUNDAY TO TUESDAY (19TH TO 21ST JULY 2020)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Weather Advisory on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that the more monsoon currents are expected to penetrate into the upper and central parts of the Country from **Sunday (19-07-2020)**. Under its influence, following weather is expected:

- Rain /wind-thundershowers (with isolated **heavy falls**) are expected in Islamabad, Kashmir, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Hafizabad, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Sheikhpura Faisalabad, Sargodha, Mianwali, Khushab, Toba Tek Singh & Jhang) and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Dir, Swat, Buner, Kohistan, Haripur, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Peshawar, Charsadda, Swabi, Mardan, Kohat, Khurram, Karak, Bannu and D.I. Khan) from **Sunday (19-07-2020) (Evening/night) to Tuesday (21-07-2020)**. Rain-thunderstorm may also occur over Gilgit Baltistan during the same period.
- Rain-thunderstorm with dust raising winds are also expected in Eastern parts of Balochistan (Zhob, Barkhan, Loralai, Musakhel and Kohlu) and Southern Punjab (D.G. Khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Layyah, Bhakkar, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur & Rahim Yar Khan) on **Monday (20-07-2020)/Tuesday (21-07-2020)**.

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
