**WEATHER OUTLOOK DURING EID-UL-AZHA FROM 31ST JULY, 2020 (FRIDAY) TO
2ND AUGUST, 2020 (SUNDAY)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Weather Outlook based on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan from **31st July, 2020 (Friday) to 2nd August, 2020 (Sunday)**. Under its influence, following weather is expected:

- Rain/wind-thundershowers with isolated **Heavy Falls** over Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sargodha & Faisalabad Divisions), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Hazara, Malakand, Peshawar, Mardan & Kohat Divisions), Balochistan (Barkhan, Khuzdar, Zhob & Musa Khel Divisions) and Kashmir from **evening/night to morning**.
- Light rain over Sindh-Makran Coast on **July 31, 2020 (Friday)** and **August 1, 2020 (Saturday)**. Rain-thundershower over Islamabad including Rawalpindi, Sialkot & Narowal (Punjab). Mansehra & Abbottabad (KP) and Kashmir.

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to take necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
