## RAINS PREDICTED IN UPPER AND CENTRAL PARTS OF THE COUNTRY FROM SATURDAY/SUNDAY( 11<sup>TH</sup> /12<sup>TH</sup> JULY 2020)

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Weather Advisory on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that the Monsoon currents are expected to penetrate into the upper and central parts of the Country from Saturday (11-07-2020). Under its influence, following weather is expected:

- Scattered rain/wind-thundershowers (with isolated heavy falls) over Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Islamabad, Punjab and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa from Saturday (11-07-2020) / Sunday (12-07-2020).
- Rain-thundershowers with dust raising winds in Eastern parts of Balochistan (Zhob, Barkhan, Loralai, Musa Khel, Sibbi & Kohlu) and Upper parts of Sindh (Sukkur, Jaccobabad & Larkana) on Sunday (12-07-2020) / Monday (13-07-2020).

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain **Alert** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
