WEEKLY SIGNIFICANT WEATHER OUTLOOK (6TH TO 12TH JULY 2020)

Flood Forecasting Division, Lahore, has issued Weekly Significant Weather Outlook for the period 6th to 12th July 2020 on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that the Monsoon activity of moderate intensity with isolated heavy falls and very heavy falls at few places is expected over Sindh & Eastern Balochistan from 6th to 9th July 2020. Rainfall activity of moderate intensity over Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Northeastern Balochistan, Gilgit Baltistan and Kashmir is likely to continue during the week (i.e. from 6th to 12th July 2020). The predicted Heavy rainfalls may generate moderate flooding in the Hill Torrents of DG Khan Division.

2. All concerned organizations are advised to remain **Alert** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
