**RAINS PREDICTED IN SOUTHERN PUNJAB, SINDH AND EASTERN PARTS OF  
BALOCHISTAN FROM THURSDAY TO SATURDAY (6<sup>TH</sup>-8<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2020)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Weather Outlook based on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan for 6<sup>th</sup> August 2020 to 8<sup>th</sup> August 2020. According to PMD **Monsoon Low Pressure from Bay of Bengal is likely to approach Sindh Province on 6<sup>th</sup> August 2020, Thursday (evening/night). Under the influence of that weather system, strong monsoon currents are expected to penetrate in Sindh, Southern Punjab and Eastern Balochistan from Thursday (evening/night) to Saturday (6<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> August 2020).**

2. As a result, widespread rain/wind-thundershowers, with **isolated Heavy to Very Heavy Falls** are expected in **Sindh (Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Tharparker, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Tando Allah Yar, Matiyari, Tando Muhammad Khan, Jamshoro, Dadu & Shaheed Benazirabad)** from Thursday (evening/night) (6<sup>th</sup> August 2020) to Saturday (8<sup>th</sup> August 2020). Scattered rain-thundershowers **with isolated Heavy Falls** are also expected in **Punjab (Bahawalpur & Rahim Yar Khan), Sindh (Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Kambarshahdadkot, Jacobabad, Kashmore & Ghotki) and Balochistan (Kalat, Jaffarabad, Jhalmagsi, Khuzdar, Lasbella & Awaran)** on Friday (7<sup>th</sup> August 2020) and Saturday (8<sup>th</sup> August 2020).

3. With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, these rains may cause **urban flooding in Karachi & Hyderabad cities of Sindh Province and flash flooding in Hill Torrents of Khuzdar of Balochistan Province on Friday (7<sup>th</sup> August 2020) / Saturday (8<sup>th</sup> August 2020)**. All concerned organizations including PDMAs/ DDMA's are advised to remain **ALERT** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
