**MORE RAINS PREDICTED IN BALOCHISTAN  
FROM FRIDAY TO SUNDAY (7<sup>TH</sup>-9<sup>TH</sup> AUGUST 2020)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Weather Advisory based on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan for 7<sup>th</sup> - 9<sup>th</sup> August 2020. According to PMD **Monsoon Low Pressure** now lies over Sindh. It is likely to move Westwards towards Balochistan during Friday evening/ night (7<sup>th</sup> August 2020). Under the influence of this weather system **Strong Monsoon currents** are expected to penetrate in Balochistan from **Friday (evening) to Sunday morning (7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> August 2020)**.

2. As a result, more rain/ wind-thundershower are expected in most parts of Balochistan from **Friday to Sunday morning (7<sup>th</sup>-9<sup>th</sup> August 2020)**. **Heavy falls** may also occur in Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbela, Awaran, Panjgur, Ketch and Gawadar during the aforementioned period. Heavy downpour may generate **Flash Flood flows** in local nullahs of Balochistan on **Friday & Saturday (7<sup>th</sup> to 8<sup>th</sup> August 2020)**. Necessary Precautionary measures in operating the local reservoirs (Small/ Medium Dams) may be taken.

3. With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations including PDMA Balochistan/ DDMA's are advised to remain **ALERT** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
