**More Monsoon Rains predicted in Sindh and Balochistan
from Saturday to Monday (29th-31st August 2020)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued Weather Advisory based on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan from (29th-31st August 2020)

2. According to PMD, another monsoon rain bearing system is likely to enter in **Sindh** on **Saturday (29th August 2020)**. Under the influence of this meteorological system, following weather conditions are expected:

- Rain/wind-thundershowers, with isolated **heavy to very heavy falls**, in Sindh (**Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Shaheed Benazirabad, Dadu, Tharparker, Nagarparker, Mirpurkhas, Islam Kot, Umar Kot, Sanghar, Sukkur & Larkana**) from Saturday (evening) to Monday (29th-31st August 2020)
- Rain-thundershowers with **isolated heavy falls** in Balochistan (**Lasbella, Khuzdar, Awaran, Barkhan, Zhob, Musa Khel, Loralai, Kohlu and Sibbi**) during Sunday and Monday (30th-31st August 2020). Rain-thundershowers may also occur in Punjab (**Bahawalpur, Rahim Yar Khan, Khanpur, Rajanpur, D.G Khan, Multan, Khanewal and Sahiwal**) during the period.

3. The predicted **Heavy rainfall** may further aggravate existing **urban flooding** in Sindh (**Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Mirpurkhas and Badin**) on Sunday and Monday (30th-31st August 2020). **Heavy downpour** may generate **flash flooding** in Balochistan (**Sibbi, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella**) and **D.G Khan** during the period.

4. With the above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned authorities including Provincial Irrigation departments and PDMAs/ DDMAs are advised to remain **ALERT**, critically watch the situation and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private & public property.
