



**Widespread Moderate/Heavy Rains Predicted in Upper parts in next three days from
Sunday to Tuesday (30th August to 01st September 2020)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued Weather Advisory based on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan from (30th August to 01st September 2020)

2. According to PMD, a strong rainy system is likely to approach in upper parts of the country that will produce **widespread rain** with **heavy fall** at a number of places in **Punjab, upper Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa, GB & AJK** during **Sunday (evening) to Tuesday (30th August to 01st September 2020)**. Under the influence of this meteorological system, following weather conditions are expected:

- **Heavy to very Heavy falls** in Punjab (**Rawalpindi, Attock Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Hafizabad, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Kasur, Okara, Faisalabad, Jhang, Sargodha, Mianwali, Khushab, Toba Tek Singh** from Monday to Wednesday (**31st August to 02nd September 2020**). Heavy falls may also occur in **Rajanpur, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur, Khanewal** (Punjab), **Zhob and Barkhan** (Balochistan) during the period.
- **Heavy to Very Heavy falls** in Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa (**Dir, Swat, Buner, Shangla, Kohistan, Haripur, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Peshawar, Charsadda, Swabi, Mardan, Kohat and Kurram**) from Monday to Wednesday (**31st August to 02nd September 2020**).

3. The predicted **Heavy rainfall** may generate **urban/flash flooding** and **Land Sliding** in vulnerable areas from Monday to Tuesday (**31st August to 01st September 2020**). Flows are expected to increase significantly in rivers, streams and local nullahs.

4. In view of the above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation, all concerned authorities, especially PDMA, DDMA, Districts Administration & Provincial Irrigation Departments are strictly advised to remain **Fully Alert**, watch the situation critically and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private & public property.
