# More Rain-Wind/Thundershower Predicted in the Upper & Lower parts of the Country from Saturday to Tuesday (July 31 to August 03, 2021)

Pakistan Meteorological Department has issued a Press Release based on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in upper parts of the country and likely to continue till **Tuesday** (**August 03, 2021**). Under the influence of this weather system, following weather is expected:

- Rain-wind-thundershower (with isolated **Heavy Falls**) over Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sargodha & Mianwali Districts), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Charsadda, Nowshera, Dir, Chitral, Peshawar, Kohat, Tank and Karak Districts) and Kashmir with occasional gaps from **Saturday to Tuesday (July 31 to August 03, 2021).**
- Rain-wind-thundershower over) Punjab (Bhakkar, Layyah, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan and Sahiwal Districts),
   Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Bannu & D.I. Khan Districts) and Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamir, Skardu,
   Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche & Kharmang Districts) during the same period.

The predicted heavy rains may cause flash flooding in some Local/Barsati Nullahs of Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sialkot & Narowal), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Shangla, Buner, Batgram, Mansehra, Balakot, Abbottabad, Swat & Kohistan), Kashmir, besides, urban flooding in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad and Sargodha divisions from **Saturday to Monday (July 31 to August 02, 2021)**.

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
