# RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED IN UPPER/CENTRAL PARTS <u>DURING THE PERIOD FROM JULY 01, 2021 TO JULY 04, 2021</u>

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that weak moist currents from Arabian Sea are penetrating into central and upper parts of the country and likely to continue during the next 2-3 days.

As a result, rain/wind/thunderstorm at scattered places are expected over Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sheikhupura and Sargodha Districts), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit Baltistan and Kashmir from **July 01, 2021** (Thursday night) to **July 04, 2021** (Sunday particularly during evening/night and morning hours). Rain/dust/thunderstorm are also expected over Punjab (Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Sahiwal, Okara, Bahawalnagar, Bahawalpur, Khanpur & Rajanpur Districts), and Balochistan (Districts Kalat, Barkhan, Loralai and Sibbi) during 3<sup>rd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> July, 2021 (Saturday & Sunday).

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
