Rain-wind/Thundershower predicted in Upper & Central parts of the Country during the Current Week <u>Monday to Friday (26th to 30th July 2021)</u>

According to Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD), strong monsoon currents are continuously penetrating into upper parts of the country and are likely to continue from 26th to 30th July 2021 (Monday- Friday). Under the influence of this weather system, following weather is expected:

- Rain-wind-thundershower (with isolated Heavy Falls) over Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sargodha & Mianwali Districts), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Charsadda, Nowshera, Dir, Chitral, Peshawar, Kohat, Tank & Karak Districts) and Kashmir with occasional gaps from 26th to 30th July 2021 (Monday to Friday).
- Rain-wind-thundershower over Punjab (Bhakkar, Layyah, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan & Sahiwal Districts), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Bannu & D.I. Khan Districts), Balochistan (Barkhan, Kohlu, Sibbi & Zhob Districts) and Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamir, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche & Kharmang Districts) from 27th to 29th July 2021 (Tuesday to Thursday).

The predicted heavy rains may generate flash flooding in Local/Barsati Nullahs of of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Shangla, Buner, Batgram, Mansehra, Balakot, Abbottabad, Swat, Kohistan, Mardan, Charsadda & Kohat Districts), Kashmir, Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sialkot, Narowal and D.G. Khan Divisions) from **Monday to Thursday** (**26**th to **29**th **July 2021**), besides, urban flooding in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad and Peshawar from Monday to Thursday (**26**th to **29**th **July 2021**)

<u>With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to</u> remain ALERT, take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
