



**Rain-wind/Thundershower predicted in Upper & Central parts of the Country during the Current Week
Monday to Friday (26th to 30th July 2021)**

According to Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD), strong monsoon currents are continuously penetrating into upper parts of the country and are likely to continue from 26th to 30th July 2021 (Monday- Friday). Under the influence of this weather system, following weather is expected:

- Rain-wind-thundershower (with isolated **Heavy Falls**) over Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Faisalabad, Sargodha & Mianwali Districts), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Charsadda, Nowshera, Dir, Chitral, Peshawar, Kohat, Tank & Karak Districts) and Kashmir with occasional gaps from 26th to 30th July 2021 (Monday to Friday).
- Rain-wind-thundershower over Punjab (Bhakkar, Layyah, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan & Sahiwal Districts), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Bannu & D.I. Khan Districts), Balochistan (Barkhan, Kohlu, Sibbi & Zhob Districts) and Gilgit-Baltistan (Ghizer, Astore, Diamir, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche & Kharmang Districts) from 27th to 29th July 2021 (Tuesday to Thursday).

The predicted heavy rains may generate flash flooding in Local/Barsati Nullahs of of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Shangla, Buner, Batgram, Mansehra, Balakot, Abbottabad, Swat, Kohistan, Mardan, Charsadda & Kohat Districts), Kashmir, Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Sialkot, Narowal and D.G. Khan Divisions) from **Monday to Thursday (26th to 29th July 2021)**, besides, urban flooding in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad and Peshawar from **Monday to Thursday (26th to 29th July 2021)**

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain ALERT, take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
