



**Rain-Wind/Thundershower Predicted In Upper & Central Parts of The Country
During The Period From August 27 To September 01, 2021**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release based on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that more monsoon currents are likely to penetrate into upper parts of the country from **Friday (27th August 2021)** and likely to continue till **Wednesday (1st September 2021)**. Under the influence of this weather system, following weather is expected:

- Rain-wind/thundershower over **Islamabad, Punjab** (Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Gujrat, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Lahore, Okara, Faisalabad, Sargodha & Mianwali Districts), **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa** (Kohistan, Shangla, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Mardan, Charsadda, Nowshera, Dir, Chitral, Peshawar, Kohat & Waziristan, Districts), **Gilgit-Baltistan** (Ghizer, Astore, Diamer, Skardu, Gilgit, Hunza, Nagar, Ghanche & Kharmang Districts) and **Kashmir** with occasional gaps from **Friday to Wednesday (27th August to 01st September 2021)**.
- **Heavy Falls** over **Islamabad, Punjab** (Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Lahore & Kasur Districts), **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa** (Dir, Kohistan, Mansehra & Abbottabad Districts) and **Kashmir** (Muzaffarabad District) from **Sunday to Tuesday (29th August to 31st August 2021)**.
- Rain-wind/thunderstorm over **Punjab** (Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Bhakkar, Layyah, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar, Dera Ghazi Khan, Rajanpur, Khanpur, Khanewal & Multan Districts), **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa** (Tank, Karak, Bannu & D.I.Khan Districts) and **Balochistan** (Kohlu, Loralai, Barkhan, Zhob, Musa Khel, Quetta, Ziarat & Kalat Districts) from **Monday to Wednesday (30th August to 01st September 2021)**.

2. The predicted heavy rainfall may generate urban flooding in Rawalpindi, Gujranwala and Lahore on **Monday/Tuesday (30th/ 31st August 2021)**. There is also likelihood of damaging effects due to wind-storm during the forecasted period.

3. **With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.**
