



Torrential Rain Predicted along Sindh- Makran Coast from 28th September to 3rd October 2021

According to Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD), a low-pressure area (remnant of the Cyclonic Storm "Gulab") currently lying over central India is likely to track in north-western direction (towards Indian Gujarat area). The system is likely to re-emerge over the Northeast Arabian Sea by **29th September (Wednesday night) / 30th Sep (Thursday morning)** and regain intensity due to favourable environmental condition. Under the influence of this weather system, following weather is expected:

- Widespread rain- wind-thunderstorms with scattered **Heavy/Very Heavy Falls Extremely Heavy** at times are likely in Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin, Mirpurkhas, Tharparkar, Umerkot, Sanghar, Shaheed Benazirabad, Nosheroferoz, Tando Muhammad Khan, Tando Allah Yar, Dadu, Jamshoro, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Shikarpur & Ghotki districts from **28th September to 2nd October 2021 (Tuesday to Saturday)**.
- Widespread rain-wind thunderstorms with scattered **Heavy /Very Heavy Falls Extremely Heavy** at time are likely in Bela, Awaran, Kech, Makran and Panjgur districts of Balochistan from **30th September to 3rd October 2021 (Thursday to Sunday)**.

The predicted heavy rains may generate urban flooding in Karachi, Badin, Thatta, Hyderabad, Dadu, Lasbela, Sonmiani, Ormara, Pasni, Gwadar, Turbat & Jiwani.

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain ALERT, take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
