RAIN/ SNOWFALL PREDICTED DURING THE COMING WEEK

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that a weather system of Light to Moderate intensity is expected to approach Western and Upper parts of the country from **18th January 2022 (Tuesday)** and may persists in upper parts upto **20th January 2022 (Thursday)**. Under the influence of this weather system, following weather is expected:

- Rain/ Snow in Balochistan (Quetta, Ziarat, Pishin, Zhob, Qila Abdullah, Kohlu and Barkhan Districts) on **18th/19th January (Tuesday/ Wednesday)**.
- Rain with snowfalls over the hills (**Light to Moderate falls**) in **Punjab** (Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Sargodha, Khushab, Mianwali, Hafizabad, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore & Kasur Districts), **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa** (Chitral, Dir, Kalam, Swat, Malakand, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Swabi, Mardan, Nowshera, Peshawar, Charsadda, Bajaur, Kurram, Waziristan, Kohat, Bannu & D.I. Khan Districts), **Kashmir** and **Gilgit-Baltistan** from **18th January to 20th January (Tuesday to Thursday morning)**.
- Light to moderate snowfall in Murree, Galliyat, Nathiagali, Kaghan, Naran, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Astore, Hunza, Gilgit, Neelum Valley, Bagh and Haveli Districts from **18th January to 20th January (Tuesday night to Thursday)**.

The predicted rainfall/snow may generate landslides in the vulnerable areas of Dir, Malakand, Swat and Kohistan of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Province, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir on **18th/ 19th January 2022 (Tuesday/ Wednesday)**.

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to to remain **Vigilant** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
