

**Rain-wind /Thunderstorm predicted in Upper parts during coming days**  
**from 05<sup>th</sup> to 10<sup>th</sup> March 2022 (Saturday to Thursday)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release on the prevailing Hydro-Meteorological conditions over Pakistan stating that a westerly wave is likely to enter western parts of the Country on Saturday (night) and likely to persist in upper parts of the Country till Thursday. Under the influence of this weather system:

- Rain-wind/thunderstorm with snow over hills is expected over Balochistan (Quetta, Ziarat, Qila Saifullah, Pishin, Zhob, & Musa Khel), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Waziristan, Dera Ismail Khan & Bannu) Punjab (Bhakkar & Layyah) from **Saturday night (5<sup>th</sup> March 2022) to Tuesday (8<sup>th</sup> March 2022).**
- Rain-wind/thunderstorm with isolated heavyfalls/ hailstorm is expected over Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Chitral, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur), Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from Saturday night (**5<sup>th</sup> March 2022**) to **Thursday (10<sup>th</sup> March 2022)** with occasional gaps. While in KP (Swabi, Mardan, Nowshera, Charsadda, Peshawar, Bajaur, Kurram, Khyber, Kohat) and Punjab (Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Jehlum, Chakwal, Mianwali, Bhakkar, Sargodha, Khushab, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Lahore and Sialkot on **6<sup>th</sup> March 2022 (Sunday) and 7<sup>th</sup> March 2022 (Monday morning).**
- Light with few moderate snowfalls is expected in Murree, Galliat, Nathiagalli, Naran, Kaghan, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Buner, Neelum valley, Bagh, Haveli, Astore, Skardu and Hunza on **Sunday, Monday, Wednesday & Thursday (6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup> & 10<sup>th</sup> March 2022).**
- The predicted Windstorm may cause damages to vulnerable structures and standing crops in Northern Balochistan, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Upper Punjab and Kashmir on **Sunday, (6<sup>th</sup> March 2022) & Wednesday/Thursday (9<sup>th</sup>/10<sup>th</sup> March 2022).**

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to to remain Vigilant and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
