## **Heat Wave Likely To Persist During The Next Week**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that most parts of the country are likely to remain in the grip of heat-wave like conditions during the next week. However, slight relief is expected in most parts of the country from 14<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> May 2022 (Saturday to Tuesday) mainly owing to dust-storms/ gusty winds, rain-thunderstorm at scattered places in the afternoon and evening/ night. Day temperatures are again likely to rise from 18<sup>th</sup> May 2022 (Wednesday).

- 2. Under the influence of the above weather system:
  - Prevailing very hot and dry weather may cause water stress on water reservoirs, crops, vegetable and orchards.
  - High temperature may cause increased energy and water demand.
  - High temperatures may increase the base flow in the rivers during the next week.
- 3. With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, <u>all concerned organizations are</u> advised to to remain **Vigilant** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time.
