MONSOON RAINS EXPECTED FROM 30TH JUNE TO 05TH JULY 2022

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that moist currents from Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal are likely to enter into upper parts of the Country from **29th June 2022** (Wednesday) which may intensify and expand to southern parts of the country by the end of this week. Under the influence of this system, following weather is expected:

- Rain-windstorm/thundershower is expected in Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Murree, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Sargodha, Hafizabad, Mandi-Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sheikhupura, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Okara, Sahiwal & Bahawalnagar), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Swat, Mansehra, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi & Nowshera), Kashmir and Gilgit Baltistan from 30th June to 04th July 2022. Isolated Heavy Falls are also expected during the period.
- Rain-windstorm/thundershower (Isolated heavy falls) in Sindh (Karachi, Hyderabad, Thatta, Badin & Dadu) and Balochistan (Zhob, Ziarat, Barkhan, Loralai, Kohlu, Quetta, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Naseerabad & Sibbi) from 1st July to 05th July 2022.

Possible Impacts:

- Heavy falls may generate Urban Flooding in Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Lahore, Gujranwala, Sialkot & Faisalabad) from 02nd to 04th July 2022 and in Sindh (Karachi & Hyderabad) from 03rd to 05th July 2022.
- Flash Flooding is also expected in local nullahs of Balochistan (Khuzdar, Lasbella, Naseerabad, Awaran, Barkhan & Kohlu) and Kashmir during the forecast period.
- Heavy rainfall may trigger landslides in Kashmir, Galiyat and Murree.

2. With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, <u>all concerned organizations are advised</u> to to remain **Alert** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
