**MONSOON ACTIVITY LIKELY TO CONTINUE IN COMING DAYS
(MORE RAINS EXPECTED FROM 6TH TO 13TH AUGUST, 2022)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that monsoon currents are continuously penetrating into the country and likely to get stronger from 10th August 2022. Under the influence of this system, following weather is expected:

- **Rain-wind/thundershower** (with isolated heavy falls) in Islamabad, northeastern Punjab, southeastern Sindh, upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, eastern Balochistan and Kashmir from 06th -09th August 2022 with occasional gaps.
- **Rain-wind/thundershower** (with scattered heavy falls) in Islamabad, Punjab, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Sindh, parts of Balochistan, Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan from 10th -13th August 2022 with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- **Heavy Rains** may generate **Urban Flooding** in Rawalpindi/Islamabad, Faisalabad, Lahore, Gujranwala, Peshawar, Nowshera and Mardan on 08th and from 10th -12th August 2022.
- **Flash Flooding** is expected in local Nullahs of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Shakargarh, Sialkot, Narowal, Abbottabad, Mansehra, Dir, Karak, Lakki Marwat, Bannu and Kashmir on 08th and from 10th -12th August 2022.
- **Heavy Rains** may generate **Urban Flooding** in Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Hyderabad, Dadu, Jamshoro, Sukkur, Larkana, Shaheed Benazirabad and Mirpurkhas from 11th -13th August 2022.
- **Flash Flooding** is expected in Qilla Saifullah, Loralai, Barkhan, Kohlu, Mosa Khel, Sherani, Sibbi, Bolan, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Awaran, Turbat, Panjgur, Pasni, Jiwani, Ormara, Gwadar and hill torrents of Dera Ghazi Khan during the forecast period. Catchment areas of Ravi, Jhelum and Chenab may receive heavy downpour causing significant rise in water level during the forecast period.
- **Rainfall** may trigger landslides in Kashmir, hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Galiyat, Murree, Chillas, Diamir, Gilgit, Hunza, Astore, Ghizer and Skardu during the forecast period.

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain Alert and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
