



**VIGOROUS MONSOON ACTIVITY IN COMING DAYS
(MORE TORRENTIAL RAINS EXPECTED IN SINDH, BALOCHISTAN AND
SOUTHERN PUNJAB FROM 14TH TO 18TH AUGUST, 2022)**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Weather Advisory stating that a depression has developed in Arabian Sea which is likely to move towards west along Makran coast. Due to this weather system, monsoon currents are continuously penetrating into Southern parts of Pakistan. Another Low Pressure Area is likely to approach Sindh Province on **16th August 2022**. Under the influence of this system, following weather is expected:

- Rain-wind thundershower (**with Few Heavy Falls**) over Islamabad, Punjab, Sindh, Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Balochistan, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from **14th to 16th August 2022 with occasional gaps.**
- Widespread rain-wind/thundershower (**with scattered Heavy to Very Heavy Falls**) over Sindh and Balochistan from **16th to 18th August 2022.**

Possible Impacts:

- **Heavy Rains** may generate **Urban Flooding** in Karachi, Thatta, Badin, Hyderabad, Dadu, Jamshoro, Sukkur, Larkana, Shaheed Benazirabad and Mirpurkhas from **14th to 18th August 2022.**
- **Flash Flooding** is expected in Qilla Saifullah, Loralai, Barkhan, Kohlu, Mosa Khel, Sherani, Sibbi, Bolan, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Awaran, Turbat, Panjgur, Pasni, Jiwani, Ormara, Gwadar and hill torrents of Dera Ghazi Khan from **14th to 18th August 2022.**
- **Heavy Rains** may generate **Urban Flooding** in Rawalpindi/Islamabad, Peshawar, Nowshera, Mardan, Faisalabad, Lahore and Gujranwala on **14th August (night) to 16th August 2022.**
- **Flash Flooding** is expected in local Nullahs of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Shakargarh, Sialkot, Narowal, Abbottabad, Mansehra, Dir, Karak, Lakki Marwat, Bannu and Kashmir on **15th & 16th August 2022.**
- **Rainfall** may trigger landslides in Kashmir, Hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Galiyat, Murree, Chillas, Diamir, Gilgit, Hunza, Astore, Ghizer and Skardu during the forecast period

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain **Alert** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
