



**RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSHOWER IS LIKELY IN UPPER PARTS OF THE COUNTRY  
DURING NEXT THREE TO FOUR DAYS**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that **Weak Monsoon Currents** from Arabian Sea are penetrating into upper and central parts of Pakistan. Under the influence of this weather system:

- Rain-wind/thundershower (with **Isolated Heavy Falls**) is expected in **Islamabad, Punjab (Rawalpindi, Murree, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sheikhpura, Mianwali, Khushab, Sargodha, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Jhang & Faisalabad), Gilgit-Baltistan, and Kashmir** from 3<sup>rd</sup> September (Saturday, night) to 6<sup>th</sup> September 2022 (Tuesday).
- Rain-wind/thundershower (with **Isolated Heavy Falls**) is expected in **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Malakand, Bajaur, Peshawar, Mardan, Charsadda, Swabi, Nowshera, Kurram, Kohat & Waziristan)** on 4<sup>th</sup> September (Sunday) & 5<sup>th</sup> September 2022 (Monday).
- Hot and humid weather is likely to continue in Sindh, Balochistan and Southern Punjab during next three to four days.

**Possible Impacts:**

- Rainfall may trigger landslides in Kashmir, hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Galiyat and Murree during the forecast period.

With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain **Alert** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
