GLOFs ALERT

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Glof Alert stating that the high temperatures in Gilgit-Baltistan (G-B) are likely to persist followed by rainfall spells during this week. As a result, the flows of river streams will increase and there is a high probability of triggering GLOF events/ Flash floods, in the vulnerable snow and glaciated areas of Gilgit-Baltistan (GB).

2. Foregoing in view, all concerned departments, district administrations and relevant local organizations are strictly advised to remain alert, vigilant and observe precautionary measures keeping in view the expected Flash Floods/ GLOF events.
