MONSOON RAINS ARE LIKELY TO CONTINUE DURING THE WEEK WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS HEAVY RAINS IN BALOCHISTAN, UPPER SINDH AND PUNJAB ON 25TH & 26TH JULY 2023

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a **Press Release** stating that Monsoon currents are continuously penetrating in the country from Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea. A fresh westerly wave is also likely to enter upper parts of the country from 26th July 2023. Under the influence of this weather system, following is expected:-

- Rain/wind-thundershower (with few heavy falls) is expected in Balochistan (Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Awaran, Kech, Gwadar, Panjgur, Kharan, Noushki, Washuk, Mastung, Sibbi, Naseerabad, Zhob, Sherani, Barkhan, Musakhel, Kohlu, Jhal Magsi, Loralai, Ziarat, Quetta, Chaman, Pishin, Qila Abdullah & Qila Saifullah) on 25th & 26th July 2023 with occasional gaps while in Punjab (Dera Ghazi khan, Rajanpur, Multan, Khanewal, Bhakkar, Layyah, Kot Addu, Bahawalpur & Rahim Yar Khan), Sindh (Tharparkar, Umerkot, Mirpurkhas, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Dadu, Shaheed Benazirabad, Hyderabad, Sanghar, Badin, Thatta and Karachi) during the period.
- Rain/wind-thundershower (with isolated heavy falls) is also expected in Punjab (Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Hafizabad, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Kasur, Mianwali, Sargodha, Khusab, Faisalabad, Toba Tek Singh, Jhang, Sahiwal, Bahawalnagar & Okara), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Chitral, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Buner, Mansehra, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Nowshera, Kurram, Lakki Marwat, Kohat, Dera Ismail Khan, Bannu, Karak & Waziristan), Gilgit Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar) and Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber & Mirpur), from 25th to 30th July 2023 with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- Heavy rains may generate Flash Flooding in Balochistan and Hill Torrents of Dera Ghazi Khan on 25th & 26th July 2023. While in Kashmir, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Shangla, Buner, Manshera, Abbottabad, Rawalpindi/Islamabad during 26th to 28th July 2023.
- Heavy rains may generate Urban Flooding in low lying areas of Sukkur, Larkana, Qamber Shehdad Kot, Noushero Feroze and Dadu on 25th/26th July 2023.
- Heavy rains may cause Urban Flooding in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Peshawar, Gujranwala, Lahore, Faisalabad from 25th to 28th July 2023 and may trigger landslides in the vulnerable areas of Murree, Galliyat, Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan and hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa during the wet period.

2. With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain <u>ALERT</u> and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
