RAIN WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS FROM 27TH TO 31ST JANUARY 2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that a Westerly Wave is likely to enter western parts of the Pakistan on 27th January 2024 and may persist over upper parts till 31st January 2024. Under the influence of this weather system, following is expected:-

- Punjab/Islamabad: Light to moderate rain in Islamabad, Pothohar region from 27th to 31st January 2024. Light to moderate rain in Murree and Galliyat during the period with occasional gaps, while in Gujranwala, Sialkot, Lahore, Narowal, Mandi Bahauddin, Mianwali and Sargodha on 30th & 31st January 2024.
- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa: Light to moderate rain with occasional in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Abbottabad, Manshera, Haripur, Kohistan, Shangla, Bunner, Karak, Peshawar, Charsada, Nowshera, Swabi, Buner, Bajaur, Kurram, Waziristan, Bannu and Kohat from 27th to 31st January 2024.
- <u>Balochistan:</u> Light to moderate rain with occasional gaps in Quetta, Zhob, Ziarat, Chamman, Barkhan and Makran coast on 28th & 29th January 2024.
- Gilgit Baltistan/ Kashmir: Light to moderate rain in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche & Shigar) and Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimbe &, Mirpur) from 27th to 31st January 2024.
- 2. With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, all concerned organizations are advised to remain ALERT and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
