



GLOF ALERT

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a GLOF Alert stating that due to persistent 'Higher than Normal' temperatures and expected rain spells from 6th to 8th July in Gilgit-Baltistan (GB) and upper parts of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP), there is **an increased likelihood of triggering GLOF events, flash floods**, landslides, and a rise in river flows due to melting of snow under warmer conditions which are expected to persist till Mid-July 2024.

2. All relevant organizations are advised to remain **Alert** and take necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of human lives and damages to public and private property.
