



MONSOON ACTIVITY IN SINDH AND EASTERN PARTS OF BALOCHISTAN ON 08th & 09th JULY 2024 AND IN UPPER & CENTRAL PARTS FROM 10th TO 15th JULY 2024

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that more **Monsoon Currents** are likely to penetrate from Arabian Sea in upper parts of Pakistan from 10th July 2024. Under the influence of these weather systems, following are expected:

- **Punjab/Islamabad:** Rain-wind/ Thundershower with few Isolated Heavy Falls in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Tala Gang, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Pakpattan, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar and Mianwali from 10th to 15th July 2024 with occasional gaps. Rain/ Thundershower in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Layyah from 12th to 14th July 2024.
- **Sindh:** Rain-wind/ Thundershower in Jacobabad, Sukkur, Shikarpur, Qamber Shahdaktot, Larkana, Dadu, Padidan, Umarkot, Tharparkar, Mirpur Khas, Badin, Sajawal, Thatta and Karachi on 08th & 09th July 2024 with occasional gaps. Rain-wind/ Thunderstorm in Sukkur, Larkana and Jacobabad on 12th & 13th July 2024.
- **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa:** Rain wind/ Thundershower with Isolated Heavy Falls in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Charsadda, Hangu, Kurram, Waziristan, Bannu and Dera Ismail Khan from 11th to 15th July 2024 with occasional gaps.
- **Balochistan:** Rain wind/ Thundershower in eastern parts of Balochistan (Khuzdar, Kalat, Ziarat, Zhob, Barkhan, Musa Khel and Shirani) on 08th & 09th July 2024 and from 12th to 14th July 2024.
- **Gilgit-Baltistan/:** Rainfall activity in Diamir, Astore, Skardu, Gilgit, Ghanche & Shigar from 11th to 15th July 2024 with occasional gaps.
- **Kashmir:** Rain wind/ Thundershower with Isolated Heavy Falls in Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber & Mirpur from 10th to 16th July 2024 with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- Heavy Falls may cause potential Flash Floods in local nullahs/ streams of Murree, Galliyat, Manshera, Kohistan and Kashmir from 12th to 14th July 2024.
- Heavy Falls may cause Urban Flooding in low lying areas in north-eastern parts of the Punjab.

2. All concerned organizations are advised to remain **ALERT** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.
