



TORRENTIAL MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN PAKISTAN
FROM 01ST TO 06TH AUGUST 2024 WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a weather advisory stating that Strong Monsoon Currents are likely to penetrate from Arabian Sea and Bay of Bengal in upper parts of Pakistan from 31st July 2024 and then in Central and Southern parts from 02nd August 2024. Under the influence of these weather systems:

- **Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-Wind/Thundershower (Scattered Heavy with Isolated Very Heavy Falls)** are expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Tala Gang, Jhelum, Mandi Bahaudin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Okara, Pakpattan, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar and Mianwali from 01st to 06th August 2024 with occasional gaps. Rain-Wind/Thundershower (with Heavy Falls) are expected in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, Khanpur, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Kot Addu, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Layyah from 02nd to 06th August 2024 with occasional gaps.
- **Sindh: Rain-Wind/Thundershower (Scattered Heavy with Isolated Very Heavy Falls)** are expected in Mithi, Sanghar, Mitayari, Nausheroferoz, Jamshoro, Umarmkot, Tharparkar, Mirpur Khas, Khairpur, Thatta, Badin, Chhor, Padidan, Sajawal, Karachi, Hyderabad, Tando Allayar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Shaheed Benazirabad, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad and Dadu from 02nd to 06th August 2024 with occasional gaps.
- **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-Wind/Thundershower (Scattered Heavy with Isolated Very Heavy Falls)** are expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Swabi, Nowshera, Mardan, Charsadda, Hangu, Kurram, Orakzai, Waziristan, Bannu, Lakki Marwat and Dera Ismail Khan from 01st to 06th August 2024 with occasional gaps.
- **Balochistan: Rain-Wind/Thundershower (with Few Heavy Falls)** are expected in Khuzdar, Lasbella, Awaran, Panjgur, Ketch, Kalat, Quetta, Ziarat, Zhob, Qila Abdullah, Qila Saifullah, Barkhan, Musa Khel, Mastung, Sibbi, Shirani, Kohlu, Bolan, Harnai, Naseerabad, Jaffarabad and Makran coast from 02nd to 06th August 2024 with occasional gaps.
- **Gilgit-Baltistan:** Rainfall activity is also expected in Diamir, Astore, Skardu, Gilgit, Ghanche and Shigar from 03rd to 06th August 2024 with occasional gaps.
- **Kashmir: Rain-wind/thundershower (with Scattered Heavy Falls)** are expected in Neelum Valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber and Mirpur from 31st July to 06th August 2024 with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- **Torrential Rains** may generate **Flash Flooding** in Local Nullahs/ Streams of Murree, Galliyat, Mansehra, Kohistan, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Bunner, Bannu, Kurram, Waziristan, Dera Ismail Khan, Orakzai, Khyber, Mohmand, Nowshera, Swabi, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Northeast Punjab, Hill torrents of D.G Khan and Kashmir from 02nd to 05th August 2024.
- **Flash Flooding** is also expected in Local Nullahs/ Streams of Kalat, Khuzdar, Barkhan, Lasbella, Zhob, Loralai, Sibbi, Harnai, Awaran, Kohlu, Dera Bugti, Jhal Magsi, Naseerabad, Musa Khel and Jaffarabad from 03rd to 05th August 2024.
- **Heavy Downpour** may cause **Urban Flooding** in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Kasur, Sialkot, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Multan, Sahiwal, Nowshera and Peshawar from 02nd to 05th August 2024.
- **Urban Flooding** is also expected in low lying areas of Sindh on 04th & 05th August 2024.

All concerned organizations are advised to remain **ALERT** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private and public property.
