RAIN-WIND/THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS OF PAKISTAN FROM 19TH TO 21ST FEBRUARY, 2025

Pakistan Meteorological Department has issued a Press Release stating that after a long dry period, a Frontal Weather System is likely to enter upper parts of the country on 19th February 2025 and will persist in Northern areas till 21st February 2025. Under the influence of this weather system:

- Punjab/Islamabad:- Rain-wind/thunderstorm are expected in Murree and Galliyat from 19th to 21st February 2025 with occasional gaps. Rain-wind/thunderstorm are expected in Islamabad, Potohar region, Sargodha, Mianwali, Bhakkar, Khushab, Hafizabad, Gujranwala, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Faisalabad, Jahng and Toba Tek Singh on 19th and 20th February 2025. Light rain-wind/thunderstorm are also expected in Multan, Dera Ghazi Khan, Layyah, Muzaffargarh, Taunsa Sharif, Khanewal, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Okara and Bahawalnagar on 19th February 2025.
- Khyber Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-wind/thunderstorm are expected in Chitral, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Bunner, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Kurram, Waziristan, Peshawar, Charsadda, Nowshera, Swabi, Bannu, Karak and Kohat on 19th & 20th February 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Balochistan: Rain-wind/thunderstorm are expected in Quetta, Ziarat, Chaman, Pishin, Qilla Abdullah, Qilla Saifullah, Chagi, Noushki, Harnai, Zhob and Musakhel on 18th and 19th February 2025.
- Gilgit Baltistan/ Kashmir: Rain-wind/thunderstorm are expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Guanche & Shigar) and Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber & Mirpur) from 19th to 21st February 2025 with occasional gaps-

Possible Impacts:

- Hailstorm at isolated places in upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, upper Punjab and Kashmir during the forecast period from 19th to 20th February 2025.
- Possibility of the landslides/avalanche in hilly areas of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan, Kashmir, Murree and Galliyat during the period.
- 2. With above likely Hydro-Meteorological situation in view, <u>all concerned organizations are advised to remain Alert and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damages to private & public property.</u>
