GLOF ALERT

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Glof Alert stating that due to a significant rise in temperatures in Northern Pakistan, the risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs) is likely to increase in low-lying glaciated areas of Gilgit-Baltistan and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa followed by weather events on 16th April onwards particularly near the terminus of the glaciers. The persistent high temperatures may accelerate snow and glacier melt and subsequent weather events, potentially triggering GLOF incidents in vulnerable valleys and surrounding regions during the current and upcoming week.

All relevant organizations are advised to remain Alert and take necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of human lives and damages to public and private property.
