## PRE-MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY FROM 20<sup>TH</sup> TO 23<sup>RD</sup> JUNE 2025 WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS

The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that moist currents from Bay of Bengal and Arabian Sea are penetrating into upper and central parts of the country and a westerly wave is also likely to approach upper parts on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2025. Under the influence of these weather systems, the following Weather is expected:

- Duststorm/rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavy fall/hailstorm) over Kashmir, Gilgit Baltistan, Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mianwali, Sargodha, Hafizabad, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujranwala, Gujrat, Sialkot, Narowal, Lahore, Faisalabad, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Haripur, Abbottabad, Mansehra, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Malakand, Battagram, Shangla, Kohistan, Peshawar, Mardan, Swabi, Nowshera, Charsadda, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Orakzai, Kurram, Kohat, Bannu, Karak, D.I. Khan and Waziristan from 20<sup>th</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Duststorm/rain-wind/thundershower over Zhob, Barkhan, Musakhel, Kalat, Dera Ghazi Khan, Multan, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar and Sahiwal from 21<sup>st</sup> to 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Duststorm/rain-wind/thundershower over Sukkur, Larkana, Dadu and Jacobabad from 22<sup>nd</sup> to 24<sup>th</sup> June 2025.

### Possible Impacts:

 Urban flooding may occur in Lahore, Gujranwala, Rawalpindi/Islamabad during the forecast period.

All concerned organizations are advised to remain **Vigilant** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private and public property.
