MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN THE COUNTRY FROM 25th JUNE, 2025

The Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that moist currents are penetrating upper and central parts of the country and likely to become intensified in next couple of days. A westerly wave is expected to approach upper parts on 25th June and likely to become significant on 26th June. Under the influence of these meteorological conditions:

Punjab/Islamabad: Rain wind/thundershower with scattered heavyfalls (at times very heavy) is expected over Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar and Mianwali from 25th June to 01st July 2025 with occasional gaps.

Rain wind/thundershower is expected in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Layyah from 26th to 28th June 2025. With occasional gaps.

- **Sindh: Rain wind/thundershower** is expected in upper and southeast Sindh (Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Kashmore, Hyderabad, Tharparkar, Mirpur Khas, Sanghar, Jamshoro, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Thatta, Badin and Karachi) from **25**th **to 28**th **June 2025** with occasional gaps.
- Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa: Rain wind/thundershower with scattered heavyfalls (at times very heavy) is expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu and Kurram from 25th June to 1st July 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Balochistan: Rain wind/thundershower is expected in Northeastern/Southern parts (Sherani, Musakhel, Loralai, Sibbi, Barkhan, Naseerabad, Kalat, Lasbella, Khuzdar, Awaran, Kalat, Jaffarabad, Dera Bugti and Kohlu) from 25th night to 28th June 2025.
- **Kashmir/Gilgit-Baltistan**: Rain wind/thunderstorm with scattered heavyfalls (at times very heavy) is expected in Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **24**th **June** (evening/night) to **02**nd **July 2025** with occasional gaps.
- Rain wind/thunderstorm is expected in Gilgit-Baltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar) from 26th to 29th June 2025 with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- **Flash Flooding:** Heavy to very heavy rainfall may cause flash flooding in local streams and nullahs of Murree, Galliyat, Mansehra, Kohistan, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Nowshera, Swabi, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, hill torrents of D.G. Khan, northeastern Punjab, and parts of Kashmir between **26**th **June and 1**st **July 2025**.
- Urban Flooding: Urban flooding is likely in low-lying areas of Islamabad, Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sialkot, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Nowshera, and Peshawar from 26th June to 1st July 2025, and in Hyderabad and Karachi during 26th to 28th June 2025.

All concerned organizations are advised to remain **Vigilant** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private and public property.
