GLOF ALERT

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Glacial Lake Outburst Flood (GLOF) Alert, indicating that a wet spell is likely to affect Gilgit-Baltistan in the current week. During this period scattered rain, thunderstorms, with isolated Heavy Falls, are expected to affect Gilgit-Baltistan. The prevailing weather conditions are likely to increase the risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOF), Flash Flood and Landslide Events in vulnerable glaciated regions of Gilgit-Baltistan.

2. All concerned organizations are therefore advised to remain **Alert** and take necessary precautionary measures to avoid loss of human lives and damages to public and private property.
