



**GLOF ALERT**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a **Glacial Lake Outburst Flood (GLOF) Alert**, indicating that a wet spell is likely to affect Gilgit-Baltistan in the current week. During this period scattered rain, thunderstorms, with isolated **Heavy Falls**, are expected to affect **Gilgit-Baltistan**. The prevailing weather conditions are likely to increase the **risk of Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOF), Flash Flood and Landslide Events** in vulnerable glaciated regions of **Gilgit-Baltistan**.

2. All concerned organizations are therefore advised to remain **Alert** and take necessary precautionary measures to avoid loss of human lives and damages to public and private property.
