MORE RAINS WITH WIND-THUNDERSHOWERS PREDICTED FROM 18TH TO 26TH JULY 2025

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that Monsoon Currents are currently penetrating Sindh and upper parts of the country and are likely to intensify in upper and central parts from 20th July 2025. A fresh Westerly Wave is likely to approach upper parts on 21st July 2025. Under the influence of these weather systems, following weather conditions are expected:

- Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-wind/thundershower with scattered Heavy Falls (at times Very Heavy) are expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar and Mianwali from 20th (evening/ night) to 25th July 2025. Rain-wind/thundershower are also likely in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan, Kot Addu and Layyah on 18th July (night), 19th July and from 21st to 23rd July 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Sindh: Rain-wind/thundershower with isolated Moderate to Heavy Falls are expected in Tharparker, Umer Kot, Mirpur Khas, Mithi, Thatta, Badin, Hyderabad, Tando Allahyar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Karachi, Shaheed Benazirabad, Khairpur, Dadu, Jacobabad, Kashmore, Sanghar, Sukkur, Ghotki and Larkana from 18th (night) to 20th July 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-wind/thundershower with scattered Heavy Falls (at times Very Heavy) are expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Karak, Bannu, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Charsadda, Nowshera, Mardan, Swabi, Hangu and Kurram from 21st to 25th July 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Balochistan: Rain-wind/thundershower are expected in Lasbella, Awaran, Khuzdar, Quetta, Zhob, Qilla Saifullah, Qilla Abdullah, Ziarat, Kalat, Sherani, Musakhel, Loralai and Barkhan on 18th July (night), 19th July and from 22nd to 25th July 2025.
- Kashmir: Rain-wind/thundershower with Isolated Heavy Falls are expected in Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber and Mirpur from 20th to 25th July 2025.
- Gilgit-Baltistan: Rain-wind/thunderstorm with Isolated Heavy Falls are expected in Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche and Shigar from 21st to 26th July 2025 with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- Heavy Rains may generate Flash Flooding in local nullahs/streams of Chitral, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Mansehra, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Buner, Charsadda, Nowshera, Swabi, Mardan, Murree, Galliyat, Islamabad/Rawalpindi and Hill Torrents of D.G Khan, Northeast Punjab and Kashmir from 21st to 25th July 2025.
- Heavy Downpour may cause Urban Flooding in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sialkot, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Okara, Nowshera and Peshawar from 21st to 25th July 2025.
- 2. All concerned organizations are advised to remain Vigilant and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private and public property.
