MORE MONSOON RAINS PREDICTED IN COMING DAYS WITH OCCASIONAL GAPS

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press Release stating that Moist Currents are penetrating in the country and likely to intensify from 13th July 2025. A fresh Westerly Wave is expected to approach in the country on 13th July 2025 evening. Under the influence of these weather systems, following weather conditions are expected:

- Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-wind/thundershower with Scattered Heavy Falls (at times Very Heavy) are expected in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Bhakkar and Mianwali from 11th to 17th July 2025 with occasional gaps. Rain-wind/thundershower with Isolated Heavy Falls are expected in Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan, Kot Addu and Layyah on 11th July & from 13th to 17th July 2025.
- Sindh: Moderate Rain-wind/thundershower are expected in Tharparkar, Mirpur Khas, Sanghar, Sukkur, Larkana, Dadu, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Hyderabad and Karachi from 15th to 17th July 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-wind/thundershower with Scattered Heavy Falls (at times Very Heavy) are expected in Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Karak, Bannu, Tank, Lakki Marwat, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Manshera, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Charsada, Nowshera, Mardan, Swabi, Hangu and Kurram from 11th to 17th July 2025 with occasional gaps.
- Balochistan: Rain-wind/thundershower with Scattered Heavy Falls (at times Very Heavy) are expected in Quetta, Zhob, Qilla Saifullah, Qilla Abdullah, Ziarat, Sherani, Musakhel, Loralai, Sibbi, Bolan, Barkhan, Naseerabad, Kalat, Lasbella, Khuzdar, Awaran, Jaffarabad, Dera Bugti and Kohlu on 11th July & from 13th to 16th July 2025.
- Kashmir: Rain-wind/thunderstorm with Scattered Heavy Falls (at times Very Heavy) are expected in Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur from 11th to 17th July 2025.
- Gilgit-Baltistan: Rainwind/thunderstorm (with isolated Heavy Falls) Greexpected in Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche, Shigar on 11th July & from 13th to 16th July 2025 with occasional gaps.

Possible Impacts:

- Heavy to very heavy rains may generate Flash Floods in local nullahs/streams of Murree, Galliyat, Manshera, Kohistan, Abbottabad, Buner, Chitral, Dir, Swat, Shangla, Nowshera, Swabi, Mardan, Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Hill torrents of D.G Khan, Northeast Punjab, Kashmir and parts of Balochistan from 14th to 17th July 2025.
- Heavy Downpour may cause Urban Flooding in low lying areas of Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Gujranwala, Lahore, Sialkot, Sargodha, Faisalabad, Nowshera and Peshawar from 13th to 17th July 2025.

2. All concerned organizations are advised to remain Vigilant and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private and public property.
