



GLOF ALERT

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a **Glacial Lake Outburst Flood (GLOF) Alert** stating that in continuation to the **GLOF Alert** issued dated 18th August 2025, the wet spell is likely to prevail from 23rd August 2025 and can affect **Gilgit-Baltistan** and **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**. During this period, scattered rain and thunderstorms with isolated heavy falls are expected in **Gilgit-Baltistan** and **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**. The prevailing weather conditions increase the risk of **Glacial Lake Outburst Floods (GLOFs)**, **Flash Floods**, and **Landslide** events in vulnerable glaciated regions of **Gilgit-Baltistan** and **Khyber Pakhtunkhwa**.

2. All concerned organizations are advised to remain **Alert** and take necessary precautionary measures to avoid any untoward situation.
