



**Torrential rain predicted in Sindh from 07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> September with occasional gaps.**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a **Weather Alert** stating that a low-pressure system is currently located over Madhya Pradesh (India) and likely to move west northwest wards and likely to reach Rajasthan and adjoining parts of Sindh on 06<sup>th</sup> September. Due to this weather system strong Monsoon currents are likely to penetrate in Sindh and eastern parts of Punjab from 06<sup>th</sup> onwards. Under the influence of these meteorological conditions, following weather is expected:

**Punjab/Islamabad: Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavy falls)** over Lahore, Kasur, Sheikhpura, Sialkot, Narowal, Okara, Sahiwal, Pakpattan, Bahawalnagar, Vehari, Khanewal, Multan, Lodhran, Bahawalpur, Rahimyar Khan, Rajanpur, Kot Addu and Dera Ghazi Khan from **06<sup>th</sup> (evening/night) to 08<sup>th</sup> September 2025**. While, at isolated places in Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad and Wazirabad during the forecast period.

**Sindh: Widespread rain-wind/thundershower (with scattered heavy to very heavy falls)** over Tharparker (Mithi, Islamkot, Nagarparkar, Chachro, Dhali, Diplo, Kaloi), Umer Kot, Mirpurkhas, Sanghar, Khairpur, Shaheed Benazirabad, Matiari, Tando Allayar, Tando Muhammad Khan, Hyderabad, Karachi, Thatta, Badin Sajawal, Jamshoro, Dadu, Kashmore, Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Shikarpur and Ghotki from **06<sup>th</sup> (evening/night) to 09<sup>th</sup> September 2025** with occasional gaps.

**Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa: Rain-wind/thundershower** over Dir, Swat, Kohistan, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Buner, Malakand, Bajaur, Mohmand, Swabi, Peshawar, Mardan, Kohat and Kurram from **07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> September 2025**.

**Balochistan: Rain-wind/thundershower (with isolated heavy falls)** over Barkhan, Musakhel, Loralai, Sibbi, Zhob, Naseerabad, Bolan, Dera Bugti, Kohlu, Kalat, Khuzdar, Lasbella, Awaran, Pasni, Ormara and Gawadar from **07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> September 2025** with occasional gaps.

**Kashmir: Rain-wind/thundershower (with Isolated heavy falls)** over **Kashmir** (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber, Mirpur) from **06<sup>th</sup> (evening) to 08<sup>th</sup> September 2025** with occasional gaps.

**Possible Impacts:**

- **Torrential rains** may cause **Urban Flood** in low lying areas of Mirpurkhas, Shaheed Benazirabad, Tharparker, Khairpur, Sukkur, Larkana, Thatta, Badin, Sajawal, Hyderabad and Karachi, from **07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> September 2025**. More rains in flood affected areas of Punjab may exacerbate the situation during the forecast period.
- **Flash Flooding** in Hill Torrents of Dera Ghazi Khan and adjoining eastern and Southern parts of Balochistan from **07<sup>th</sup> to 09<sup>th</sup> September 2025**.
- **Landslides** may cause roads closure in the vulnerable hilly areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Murree, Galliat and Kashmir during the forecast period.

All concerned organizations are advised to remain **Vigilant** and take all necessary precautionary measures well in time to avoid loss of precious human lives and damage to private and public property.
