



**DUST/WINDSTORM & RAIN-THUNDERSTORM PREDICTED IN UPPER PARTS OF THE
COUNTRY FROM 11TH TO 13TH JUNE 2026**

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued a Press release stating that a Western Disturbance is likely to approach upper parts of the country from **11th June 2026** and likely to persist till **13th June 2026**. Moist currents from Arabian sea are also likely to penetrate upper and central parts from **11th June 2026**. Under the influence of this, the following is expected:

- **Punjab/Islamabad:** Scattered dust/windstorm & rain-thunderstorm (with few heavyfalls/hailstorm) over Islamabad/Rawalpindi, Murree, Galliyat, Attock, Chakwal, Jhelum, Mandi Bahauddin, Gujrat, Gujranwala, Hafizabad, Wazirabad, Lahore, Sheikhupura, Sialkot, Narowal, Sahiwal, Jhang, Toba Tek Singh, Nankana Sahib, Chiniot, Faisalabad, Okara, Kasur, Khushab, Sargodha, Noorpuhal, Bhakkar, Layyah Mianwali, Bahawalpur, Bahawalnagar, D.G. Khan, Multan, Khanewal, Lodhran, Muzaffargarh, Rajanpur, Rahimyar Khan and Kot Addu from **11th to 13th June 2026** with occasional gaps.
- **Kashmir/Gilgit-Baltistan:** Scattered rain-wind/thunderstorm (with few heavyfalls/hailstorm) over Kashmir (Neelum valley, Muzaffarabad, Rawalakot, Poonch, Hattian, Bagh, Haveli, Sudhanoti, Kotli, Bhimber & Mirpur) and GilgitBaltistan (Diamir, Astore, Ghizer, Skardu, Hunza, Gilgit, Ghanche & Shigar) from **11th to 13th June 2026** with occasional gaps.
- **Khyber-Pakhtunkhwa:** Scattered dust/windstorm & rain-thunderstorm (with few heavyfalls/hailstorm) over Dir, Chitral, Swat, Kohistan, Malakand, Bajaur, Shangla, Battagram, Buner, Kohat, Bannu, Dera Ismail Khan, Bajaur, Mohmand, Khyber, Waziristan, Orakzai, Mansehra, Abbottabad, Haripur, Peshawar, Mardan, Hangu and Kurram from **11th to 13th June 2026** with occasional gaps.
- **Balochistan:** Dust/windstorm & rain-thunderstorm over Northeastern parts (Zhob, Sherani, Ziarat, Qillah Saifullah, Barkhan & Dera Bugti) from **11th to 13th June 2026**.
- **Sindh:** Dust/windstorm over upper Sindh (Sukkur, Larkana, Jacobabad, Khairpur, Dadu, Ghotki, Kashmore, Shikarpur & Shaheed Benazirabad) from **11th to 13th June 2026**.

Possible Impacts

- **Heavy rains** may cause **Urban/Flash flooding** in Rawalpindi/Islamabad, Gujranwala, Sialkot, Lahore and Faisalabad.
- **Landslides** may occur in vulnerable areas of upper Khyber Pakhtunkhwa, Gilgit-Baltistan and Kashmir from **11th to 13th June 2026**.

All concerned organizations are advised to remain **Fully Alert & Vigilant** and take prompt actions to ensure safety of communities living in low lying areas, public & private property besides irrigation, drainage & flood protection infrastructure etc.
