FLOOD ADVISORY – HIGH FLOOD LEVEL IN RIVER CHENAB

Pakistan Meteorological Department (PMD) has issued latest hydro meteorological conditions as under;

- Heavy rainfall observed from the latest hydro-meteorological conditions and Sialkot Weather Radar over the River Chenab catchment has resulted in High Flood conditions.
- Rainfall has now decreased across the major sub-catchments and river flows are expected to remain high for the next 6 to 8 hours before gradually decreasing.
- River Chenab and its Upper Catchment areas are influenced by recent Heavy Rainfall.
- High flows are expected to persist for the next 6 to 8 hours at Marala, followed by a gradual recession if current rainfall trends continue.

Possible Impact

- River Chenab at **Marala** is expected to remain at **High Flood Level** during the next 6 to 8 hours.
- Water levels are expected to gradually recede thereafter as rainfall continues to weaken over the catchment.
- **Khanki** and **Qadirabad** are also expected to attain **High Flood Level** during the next 10 to 18 hours.

Advisory:

All concerned organizations are advised to remain **Fully Alert & Vigilant** and take prompt actions to ensure safety of communities living in low lying areas, public & private property besides irrigation, drainage & flood protection infrastructure etc.
